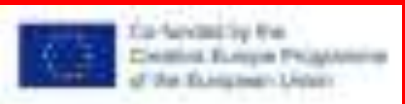

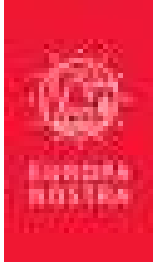

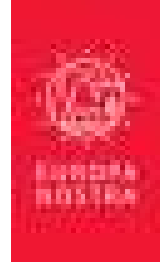

Map of the 29 sites inscribed on the 7 Most Endangered lists since 2013



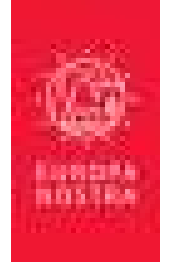

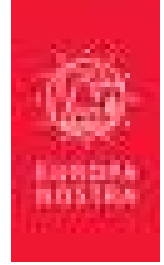
