Ensuring a stronger presence in Brussels



- Dialogue with representatives of the Council of Europe and the EU Institutions (European Commission, European Parliament, Council of Ministers, Committee of the Regions, European Economic and Social Committee)
- Building a wider network of civil society

 (a.o. with other European networks working in the wider field of cultural heritage, representatives of the civil society and other public authorities, regions, cities, etc.; participation in the structured cultural sector dialogue)
- Contribution to policy making (contribution to European consultations, lobbying on legislations with an impact on cultural heritage)
- Running programmes with the support of EU Institutions

European Heritage Alliance 3.3



- launched in June 2011 at the EN Congress in Amsterdam by 25 European organisations working in the wider field of cultural heritage
- first time Europe's major European & international heritage networks agreed to work together to promote the untapped potential of Europe's cultural heritage
- 31 members in April 2013
- First joint document produced in May 2012 "Towards an EU Strategy for Cultural Heritage – a Case for Research"
- Joint mission: Strengthening the heritage lobby in Europe
