- connect: from people to people."








12 European heritage sites shortlisted for the 7 Most Endangered programme 2018, 16 January 2018








Europe's 7 Most Endangered heritage sites 2018 announced, 15 March 2018








Map of the 29 sites inscribed on the 7 Most Endangered lists since 2013


