BELGIUM-FLANDERS

With a view to making a sound decision, we would like to know:

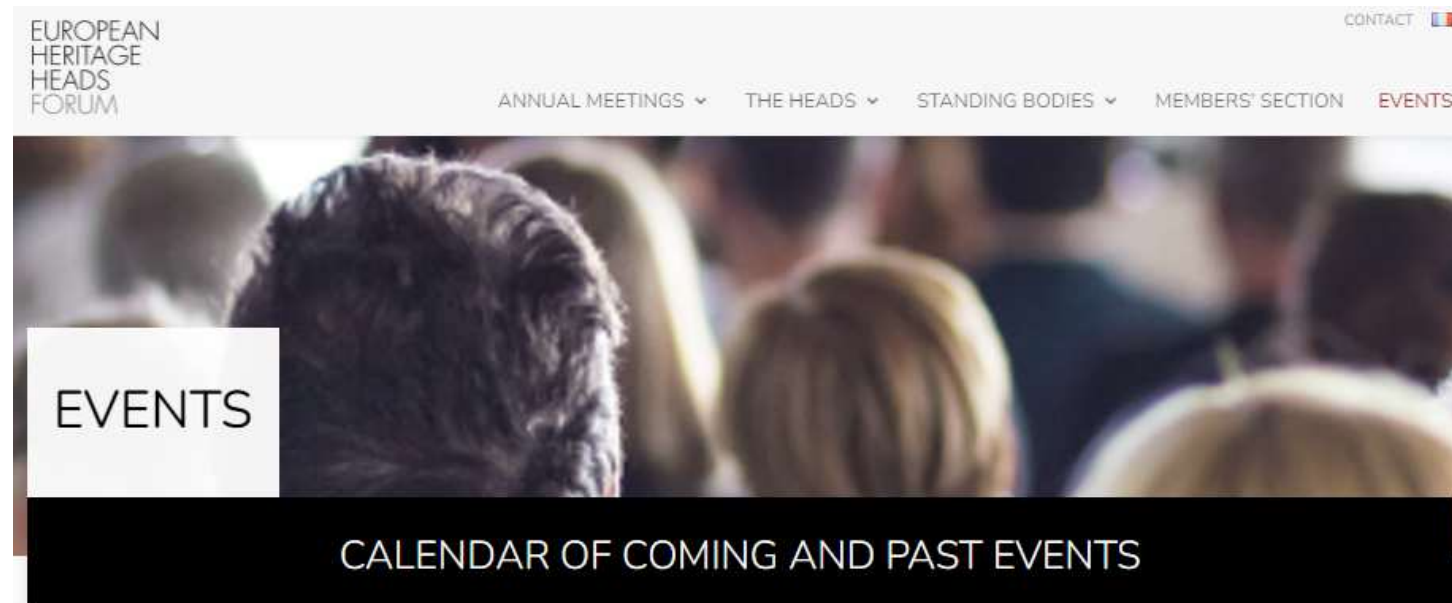
- What is your current policy on solar panels in heritage context?

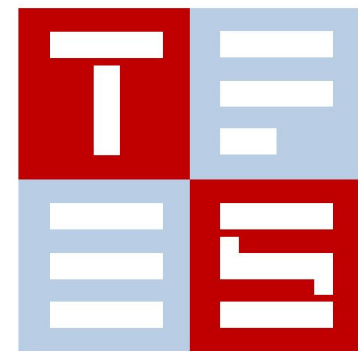
